• Improve source segregation of food waste by stakeholders such as tenants, cleaning staff and/or patrons

• Accurately track and measure the amount of segregated food waste generated by tenants within premises

• Develop a robust on-site food waste treatment system that optimises use of space and generates useful output for commercial premises

Submit your proposal via the SOIC portal by **19 February 2021, 12PM (GMT+8)** for the opportunity to receive up to S\$1 million for solution development projects and up to 50% of co-funding support for potential solution adopters.
